It seems that the points on the block might be interpreted to be the love of God going out to the world.

## **Luther Rose**

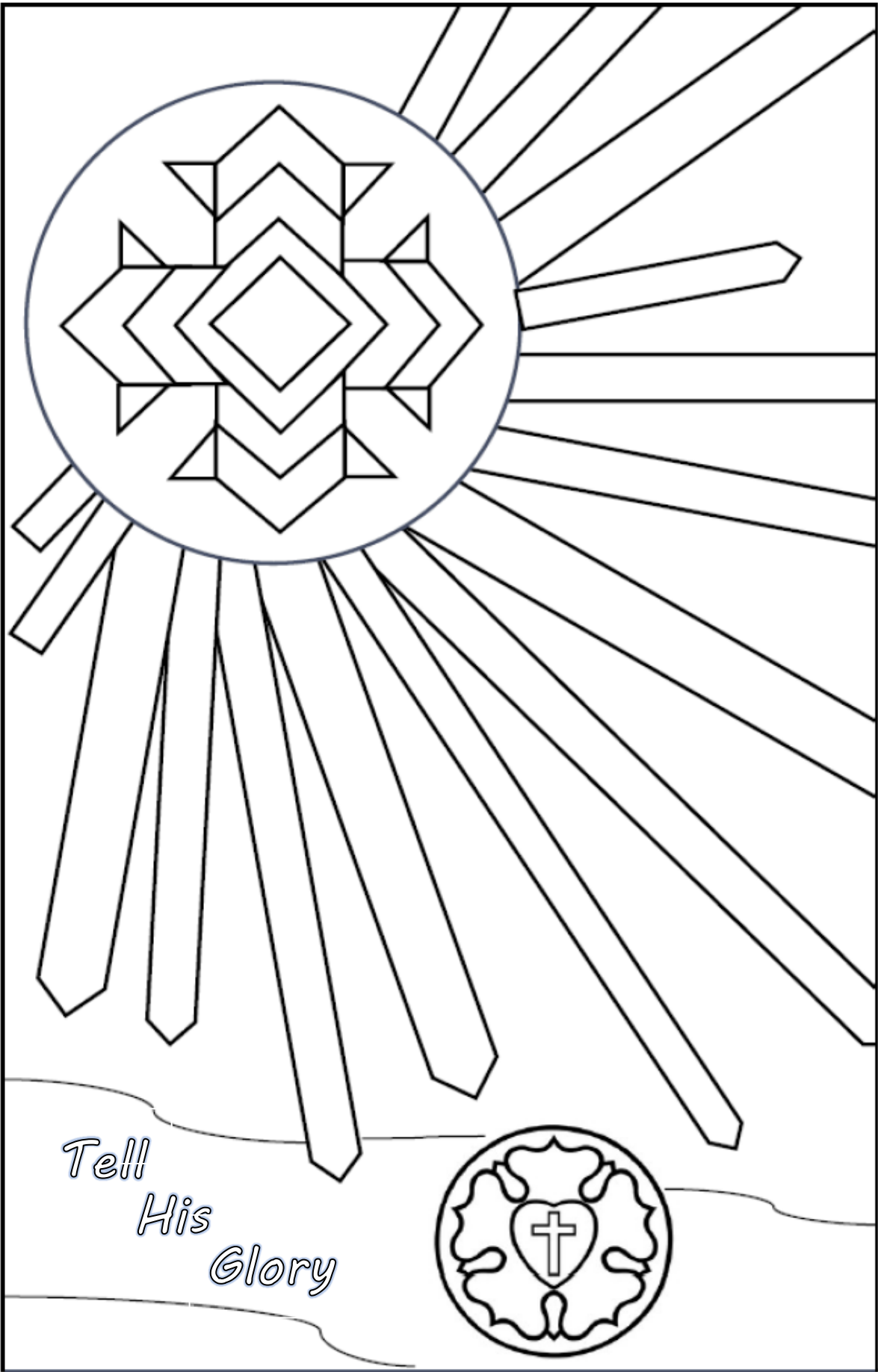
